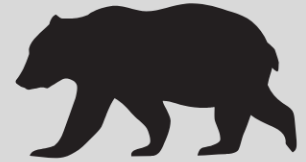




NEW Zoo Scavenger Hunt ANSWER KEY

we have three different species of **CRANE**. Can you list them?



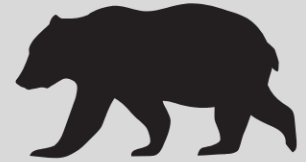
