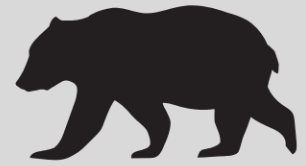




NEW Zoo Scavenger Hunt

Look closely at our **GOATS**; what shape are their pupils? (circle one)



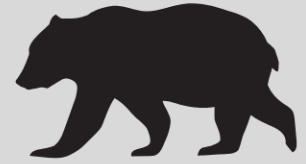
4. Every animal at the NEW Zoo has their own name!
